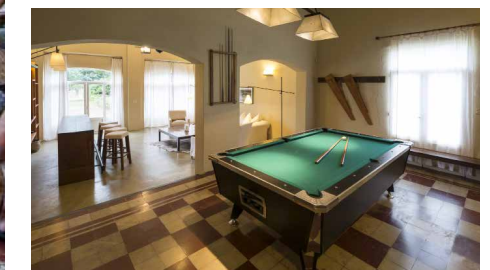

At Pica Zuro short drives are the norm: the lodge is positioned to reach hundreds of private-access shooting locations within minutes. There are never-ending flocks, all year round.

Each day, shooters leave the pastoral setting of the lodge and move to the hills and fields, where doves fly in spectacular numbers.

Upon returning to the lodge, our skilled chefs assure that meals are fit for a king. Pica Zuro's staff—including guides and tenured field assistants—see to every detail, so your focus remains down the rib of your gun.

LOCATION

- Located in the province of Cordoba, in central Argentina, 60 miles (100 km) north of the Cordoba City international airport. Driving time 1:15 hr.

Getting There

- To get to Pica Zuro Lodge there are daily direct flights from many U.S. cities to Santiago, Chile with connecting flights to Cordoba city. That will allow you to make the most of your trip as you will be dove shooting the day of your arrival.
- Hunters may also fly into Buenos Aires (Ezeiza International Airport), transfer to the domestic airport and take a 1 hr flight to Cordoba.

FACILITIES AND SERVICES

- **CAPACITY:** 14 guns.
- **ACCOMMODATION:** 5 twin rooms and 4 single rooms, each with private bathroom.
- Single Room Upgrade: US\$100 per night.
- Dining room, sitting room, bar, recreation room, billiards table, gun cleaning table and facilities.
- Swimming pool, dry sauna, masseuse, jacuzzi.
- Satellite telephone, Internet access and satellite TV.

THE SHOOTING

- Córdoba is considered the dove shooting capital of the world. The 100 square mile radius (160 km) around the lodge is annually inhabited by over 40,000,000 million doves. The lodge enjoys 75 shooting fields all within a scenic drive through the region's rich farmland.
- Each day the lodge donates hundreds of doves to Mission Esperanza Foundation. We feed 800 children per day and have already built 3 community centers with our donations and those of our guests.
- The program generally starts at 8:00 AM with a hearty breakfast and short drive to the shoot.
- In the field you will be assigned a personal field assistant, who will provide you with shells and refreshments and direct you to your shooting stand.
- Typically, you will shoot until noon when you will be treated to an incredible barbeque lunch, shaded by a unique hand-made shelter, with lunch featuring Argentina's wonderful beef and superb wines.
- Afternoon hunts begin at around 2 or 2:30, and continue until almost dark.
- There is no defined ending time for the shooting-we depart when you are ready.
- Return to the lodge for cocktails and early dinner.

HUNTING

David Denies offers a grand variety of wing shooting sport, including four uniquely beautiful lodges near Cordoba, **Argentina**, the world capital of dove shooting. Three of these Cordoba lodges focus on Dove, while the 4th is focused on Decoyed-Pigeons. Our dove lodges are 10 months of the year from January thru October, meaning you can easily combine for two or three days of world-class dove shooting while you are in Argentina or Chile with your fishing. There are also two majestic mixed bag lodges in **Uruguay**, offering walk up hunting for partridge over pointing dogs, pigeons and doves. Then two more lodges near Buenos Aires: Jacana Lodge hosts duck hunters seeking the best duck hunting on the planet, and Los Crestones, located only 2 hours from Buenos Aires airport (EZE), offer not only ducks, partridge, and dove, but big game as well (Black Buck Antelope & Axis Deer).

BIG GAME

Red Stag Patagonia, outfits some of the best Red Stag hunts in both **Argentina** and **Chile** as well as best free-range Black Buck and Axis Deer hunting in South America. Our four operations are located in Chile, Northern Patagonia, Mendoza and Buenos Aires. All of Red Stag's hunts are fair chase, open country hunts in magnificent terrain, and their success rate speaks for itself.
