TRAVELLING TO ARGENTINA DURING COVID-19

We would like to provide the best explanation about the current requirements for traveling to Argentina. Please know this is still a dynamic process and we will have to continue to update the communication as requirements change with little notice.

UNVACCINATED TRAVELERS



Prior to Arrival

- All those traveling to Argentina, regardless of their vaccination status, will be required to obtain a negative COVID-19 test (PCR), taken no more than 72 hours prior to boarding the flight to Argentina
- All persons traveling to Argentina are required to have medical insurance with comprehensive cover for COVID-19.
- All persons are required to fill in a <u>Migrations affidavit</u> done 48 hours prior to boarding the flight.



Prior to Arrival

- All those traveling to Argentina, regardless of their vaccination status, will be required to obtain a negative COVID-19 test (PCR), taken no more than 72 hours prior to boarding the flight to Argentina.
- All persons traveling to Argentina are required to have medical insurance with comprehensive cover for COVID-19.
- All persons are required to fill in a
 <u>Migrations affidavit</u> done 48 hours
 prior to boarding the flight.



Upon Arrival to Argentina

 All unvaccinated travelers must take a COVID-19 test on arrival.



Upon Arrival to Argentina

• Proof of full vaccination scheme (vaccination card showing you got

- all the doses, depending on what vaccine you've chosen). Last application must be taken at least 14 days prior to traveling.
- Vaccinated travelers are not required to quarantine upon arrival, but they must do a PCR-type test between the third to fifth day of arrival in the country.



Upon return to the U.S.

 All travelers entering the United States are required to have a negative COVID-19 test taken no more than 1 day prior to boarding the flight back, or have documentation proving recovery from COVID-19 within the last 3 months. The result must read 'negative' or 'not detected'. It won't be accepted if it reads 'invalid'. Test will be available at the lodge.

- All unvaccinated adults are required to quarantine for 7 (seven) days upon arrival.
- All minors below the age of 18 years old are not required to quarantine.
- Unvaccinated travelers must take a COVID-19 PCR test on the 7th day after arrival to end quarantine.



Upon return to the U.S.

 All travelers entering the United States are required to have a negative COVID-19 test taken no more than 1 day prior to boarding the flight back, or have documentation proving recovery from COVID-19 within the last 3 months. The result must read 'negative' or 'not detected'. It won't be accepted if it reads 'invalid'. Test will be available at the lodge.

BOTTOM LINE

We have a safety system in place and feel comfortable operating in these trying times. Nevertheless, that does not eliminate the risk. Please understand that if you travel to Argentina and contract COVID-19, you could be responsible for a great personal expense, whether it is a quarantine or a medical expense.

In this context, we strongly encourage our clients to purchase medical insurance with comprehensive cover for coronavirus, including hospitalization and the costs of self-isolation if required. Customers are solely responsible for purchasing medical, travel, or trip insurance.
